1 This matter came before the Court on Defendants-Appellants' "Joint Motion
2 for Designation of Partial Electronic Record and Extension of Time to File Docketing
3 Statements." The Court **FINDS** that

4 1. The record proper in this case consists of approximately 16,000 pages;

5 2. The Eleventh Judicial District Court maintains a website on which are posted
6 the documents filed in the sub-proceeding in this adjudication;

7 3. An un-paginated electronic record proper would be impractical for the Court's
8 review on appeal;

9 4. The service of the docketing statement on the district court triggers the
10 preparation of the record proper.

11 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that

12 1. The parties are ordered to meet and discuss in good faith how to limit the paper
13 record proper;

14 2. The parties will report back in writing to this Court by February 21, 2014,
15 whether or not they can reach an agreement on the designation of a paper
16 record;

17 3. If the parties cannot reach an agreement on the designation of a paper record,
18 the Court will refer this matter to a special master, with the costs to be borne
19 by the parties.

the docketing statement is **HEREBY DENIED**.


